



NOTICE OF SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITY

James Reinowski Memorial Scholarship Fund

The Illuminating Engineering Society is an organization established for the advancement and dissemination of theoretical and practical knowledge of the science and art of illumination.

Applicants must be registered in a 4+ year program or advanced degree at a college or university and working toward a degree in engineering, technical theater, science, architecture, interior design, or a related degree whose curriculum is related to illumination.

Applicants must provide:

- ◆ Proof of registration (photocopy of current student ID or transcript)
- ◆ List of extracurricular activities
- ◆ List of awards or other recognitions
- ◆ One page essay addressing what interests the applicant about the lighting industry

The Board of Managers will award recipients on the basis of grade point average, relevance of coursework, extracurricular activity, participation in IES Section or student IES chapter, communication skills, and the student's intent to contribute to the lighting industry. Award amounts start at \$500.

Applicants may be awarded the James Reinowski Memorial Scholarship no more than two times during their college career.

Applicants who will be entering their final two years of undergraduate education or at any point in their advanced degree should apply by March 31st. Applications will be reviewed and announced in April.
